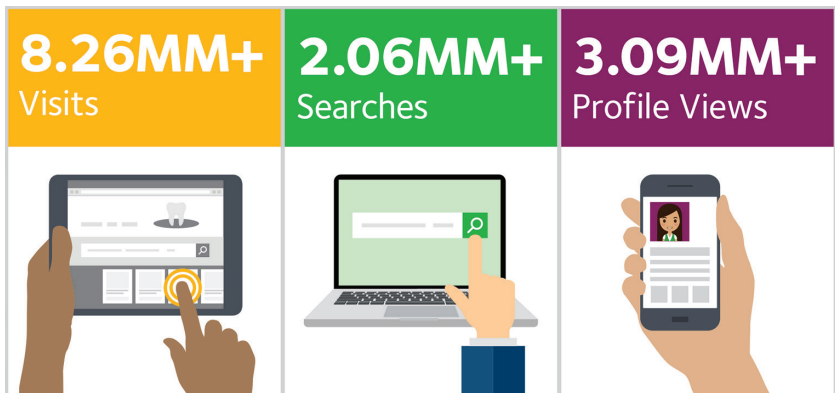

Also, it is important to remember that New York's Dental Practice Act is a "living" document which is continually subject to amendment.

Peer Review

New York State Dental Association members demonstrate their commitment to quality care through our Peer Review and Quality Assurance Program.

Peer Review provides a confidential, impartial and timely way to resolve complaints about the appropriateness and quality of dental treatment provided by NYSDA-member dentists. Participation in this alternative dispute resolution process is a membership requirement.

A Guide to Peer Review outlines the process a Peer Review case undergoes on its way to resolution.

HOW PEER REVIEW WORKS

Patient calls local district dental society to discuss concern about member dentist.

Local district office determines if the concern qualifies for a peer review. If so, the patient is provided with *A Guide to Peer Review* and an *Agreement to Submit to Peer Review*.

The local district office sends the *Agreement* to the dentist the patient is complaining about for his/her statement and signature. The member dentist must return copies of the patient's treatment records and financial information to the local district office with the *Agreement*.

The Peer Review Committee then determines whether the complaint can be resolved by Peer Review. If eligible for Peer Review, mediation will be conducted. A mediator will contact both the patient and dentist.

If the dentist and patient come to a mutual agreement, the case will be closed. No refund can be greater than the amount the patient actually paid for the treatment.

If the complaint is not settled by mediation, a hearing will be held.

The local district dental society notifies the patient of the proceeding's outcome by way of a decision letter.

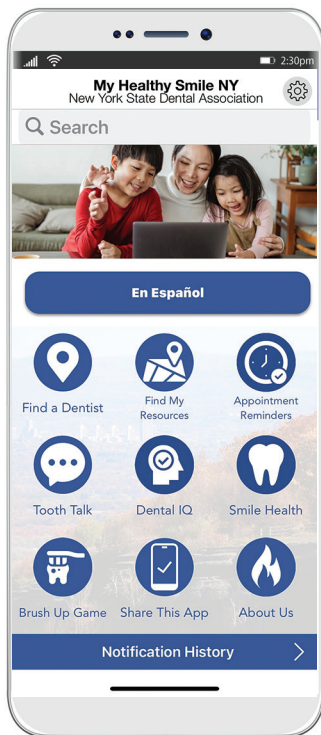
New York State Dental Demonstration Project (DDP) nysdental.org/DDP

The Dental Demonstration Project (DDP) is a state-funded project that began in 2015 and serves New Yorkers across the state.

Our mission is to link patients to health homes in their communities; to engage support of volunteer dentists; and to leverage the clinic partners to improve access to dental care for underserved populations.

My Healthy Smile

My Healthy Smile NY is a free downloadable app created by the New York State Dental Association. This innovation is designed to link patients to oral health education, resources and ADA member dentists in their communities throughout New York State.



Continuing Education & Licensure Requirements

New Dentists in First Year of Practice

nysdental.org/member-center/ce

Your residency program will count as 60 credits; however, you will still be responsible for taking the courses mandated by New York State before your license expires.

Mandatory Courses

nysdental.org/member-center/ce

New York State's Mandatory Continuing Education Law requires that a dentist obtain at least 60 credit hours of CE every three years. The New York State Education Department ultimately decides which courses qualify.

Requirements for each three-year registration period:

- 60 continuing education credit hours for every three-year registration period. 18 out of the 60 credits can be home study.
- New York State Mandated Courses:
 - Ethics and Jurisprudence course (once in your lifetime)
 - Tobacco Cessation/Oral Cancer course (once in your lifetime)
 - Child Abuse course (once in your lifetime).
 - Infection Control course (once every four years).
- CPR course: you must maintain a current certificate (varies one to three years). CPR must be taken in person.

Practice management courses are not accepted by the State Education Department and cannot count towards the 60-credit total.

Dental Anesthesia and Sedation

Dentists must apply for a certificate with the New York State Education Department in order to administer general anesthesia, deep sedation or conscious sedation (parenteral or enteral route, with or without inhalation agents) in their professional practice at locations other than general hospitals.

Responsible Opioid Prescribing

Prescribers licensed in New York State to treat humans and who have a DEA registration number to prescribe controlled substances, as well as medical residents who prescribe controlled substances under a facility DEA registration number, must complete at least three (3) hours of coursework or training in pain management, palliative care, and addiction.

Practitioners must notify the Department of Health that they have completed the educational requirements by submitting an attestation online.

The NYSDA Continuing Education (CE) Registry

The NYSDA CE Registry is a valuable benefit provided to members. It serves as a platform for recordkeeping and documentation of continuing education (CE) courses. By participating in the registry, members have access to their official CE transcript, which can be viewed online through the members-only section of the NYSDA website.

The NYSDA CE Registry is particularly important in cases where members may be audited by the New York State Education Department. During an audit, dental professionals may be required to provide evidence of completing the necessary continuing education requirements. In such instances, the official transcript from the NYSDA CE Registry can serve as a reliable source of documentation, demonstrating the completion of relevant CE courses.

Members can conveniently access their transcript online by logging into the members-only section on the NYSDA website. Alternatively, if a member prefers a paper copy of their transcript, they can request it by submitting a request online, and it will be sent via email within 3-5 days.

Please note, you are required to keep all copies of your certificates for six (6) years in the event of an audit.

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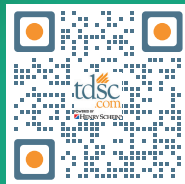
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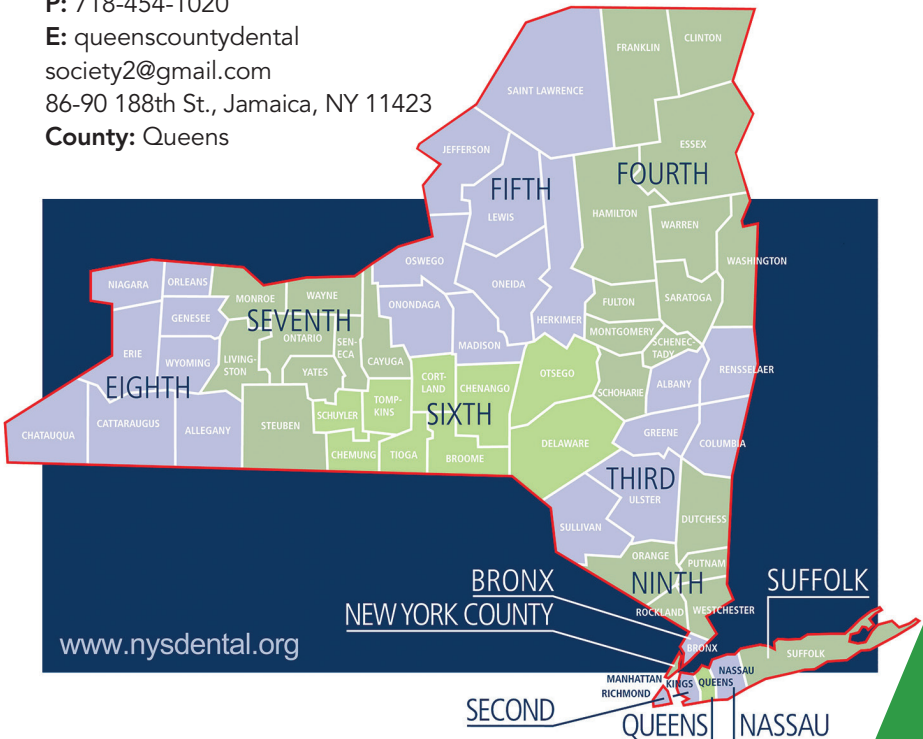
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
